## **Home Inspection Checklist**



Parents, use this check-list and walk around your home with your kids. Check off items on the list that apply to your home to help make sure your home is fire safe!

 _ Does an adult always stay in the kitchen when food is cooking on the stove?
 _ Are curtains and other things that can burn well away from the stove?
 _ Is there a "kid-free" zone of three feet around the stove when an adult is
cooking?
 _ Are matches and lighters stored up high, away from children?
 _ Does an adult always stay in rooms with lit candles?
 _ Do adults blow-out candles when they leave the room or go to bed?
 _ Does your fireplace have a sturdy screen to catch sparks?
 _ Has your chimney been inspected and cleaned during the past year?
 _ Has your furnace been serviced by a professional in the past year?
 _ Are propane tanks and other fuels stored outside your home?
 $\_$ Are portable space heaters always turned off when adults leave the room or go
to bed?
 _ If space heaters are used in your home, are they at least three feet away from
anything that can burn, including people, furniture and pets?
 _ If people smoke, do they smoke outside the home?
 _ Are electrical cords in good condition, without cracks or frayed areas?
 _ Are kitchen appliances, such as the coffee-maker, toaster oven, and microwave plugged into separate receptacle outlets?
_ Does your home have smoke alarms in every sleeping room, outside each
 sleeping area and on every level?
_ Are your smoke alarms interconnected so when one sounds, they all sound?
_ Do you test your smoke alarms monthly?
Do you practice your escape plan with your family at least twice a year?
Do you have residential fire sprinklers in your home?
 _ Does everyone know what to do if the sprinkler goes off?
